O PREVENTION MEASURES



- All employees, volunteers, and exhibitors are expected to **fill out the Exposure**Control Plan (health questionnaire) daily and returned it to security before entry through Gate 7. If any employee, volunteer, or exhibitor states "Y" (Yes), please inform the CEO or Fair Manager immediately.
- All employees, volunteers, and exhibitors will receive a **temperature check** at Gate 7 before entry. Any person presenting a body temperature above 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit will not be permitted to access the fair.
- All employees, volunteers, and exhibitors shall **comply with all health and safety orders, rules, and guidelines** related to the virus promulgated by the State of California, County of San Mateo, City of San Mateo, and the San Mateo County Fair.

O WEAR PROTECTIVE GEAR - PRACTICE SOCIAL DISTANCING



- Personal protective equipment is required by employees, volunteers, and exhibitors on the property; this includes face coverings and when appropriate, gloves.
- Face masks are required by exhibitors exiting their vehicle during entry receiving and pick up.
- All employees, volunteers, and exhibitors agree that they will wear a face mask at all times, wash hands frequently, use hand sanitizer or antibacterial wipes, maintain social distancing, and submit to non-invasive body temperature measurement.
- Department heads must monitor crowd sizes within their departments.

O LOGISTICS



- · All exhibitor tickets will be sent via email or, if requested, via text.
- All employees, volunteers, and exhibitors will be available for **curbside entry** receiving and pick up. Masks should be put on and volunteers should be socially distanced while waiting for exhibitors.
- Exhibits will **NOT** be received in the administration office at any time.
- Exhibits will **NOT** be picked up in the administration office at any time.

STAY AT HOME IF:
