II. <u>CEO General Update</u>

A. <u>CEO Update</u>

CEO Stoehr reported on the following:

- The building name signs have been installed on Expo and Fiesta Halls.
- The County's vaccination clinics have concluded.
- The County's PPE operation is expected to conclude by March 15th.
- We are transitioning back to hosting events and have a Mexican concert scheduled on February 26th.
- The accounting software conversion is in progress and is going well. The Board will receive preliminary year end financials at the February board meeting.
- The City of San Mateo will give a presentation at the board meeting to provide an update on the UFES project and the Gate D2 encroachment.
- Engie Solar will provide a presentation to the board proposing solar expansion at the Event Center.
- The Jockey Club will follow the California mask guidance and will not require masks in the Jockey Club beginning this weekend. Guests will continue to be required to show proof of vaccination. The volleyball client has elected to continue the masking requirement for their events.
- The Progress Seminar is scheduled for April 29-May 1 and information will be sent to the Board.
