GROW COMPETITIVE EXHIBITS PARTICIPATION RATE

Partner with county libraries to provide events that involve the community with making entries. Engage more with our audience regarding contests. Reach out to after-school programs, Boys and Girls Club and similar groups

BRING MORE ANIMALS

Bring back the Petting Zoo. Grow partnerships with Peninsula Humane Society and CuriOdyssey.
