I. <u>Oral Communications</u>

There were no oral communications.

II. <u>Board Retreat Discussion</u>

President Wong reported the board retreat will be held on Saturday, March 25 from 8:30 am to 12:00 pm. CEO Stoehr suggested and the committee agreed that our new status as a Community Resilience Center for the County be the topic at the retreat with the board exploring what it means to be a resilience center. In addition, the board will update our mission statement to align with the SMCEC's new mission.

III. CEO General Update

CEO Stoehr reported on the following:

- An application is in process with CDFA for an \$8 million grant. The grant criteria requirements include year-round operations to benefit the underserved communities; emergency services and addressing deferred maintenance and infrastructure. Our application focuses on the renovation of Redwood Hall including adding 6,700 sq. ft. of space, restrooms and office space. Upon completion, the SMCEC would partner with Samaritan House to lease the space to serve the community.
- The Fiesta Hall heating project is in progress with an anticipated completion date of March 23rd.
- The City of San Mateo is requesting an extension of their easement to November 2024. This will be an action item on the board meeting agenda.
- The SMCEC management staff participated in active shooter training with the San Mateo Police Department. This training will be expanded to additional staff and we are working on implementing a mass communications system to alert staff of any emergency situation.
- Event sales are strong with a busy 2024 calendar.

IV. <u>Future Agenda Items</u>

AB 361 regarding remote meeting requirements was discussed as the law has been extended to January 1, 2024. The committee agreed that committee meetings would continue to be offered in a hybrid format. Board members will be asked to attend a minimum of 50% of board meetings in person.
