## II. Northern California Horse Racing Update

CEO Stoehr provided an update on Northern California horse racing. Golden Gate Fields is scheduled to close on June 9<sup>th</sup> and the Fair racing circuit will run through October. She reported we continue the efforts to explore potential lease opportunities on the property.

## III. <u>Ticket Policy Discussion</u>

- Fair planning is going well for the June 1<sup>st</sup> opening.
- The Hillsborough Antique Show will be going to collections for their canceled event.
